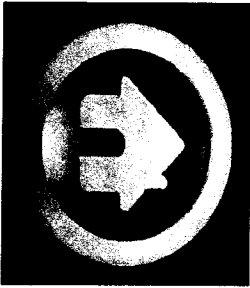


# Dane County Housing Stabilization Project

The Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-housing Program (HPRP) was created by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009.

HPRP provides financial assistance and services to either prevent individuals and families from becoming homeless or help those who are experiencing homelessness to be quickly re-housed and stabilized.

HPRP assistance is not intended to provide long-term support for program participants. Assistance is temporary and will help individuals and families become linked to the help needed to stabilize housing.



### Who can get assistance?

1. Do you have an eviction notice?
2. Do you have a notice of utility shut-off?
3. Are you currently homeless?
4. Do you have a court date for an eviction?
5. Is your income less than the following amounts? (50% of County Median Income)

If you can answer yes to ONE of these then HPRP might be able to help!

### Where do I go to get help?

There are 10 agencies serving Greater Madison and surrounding Dane County with HPRP services.

#### *In greater Madison:*

Porchlight, The Road Home, The Salvation Army, Tellurian UCAN, Tenant Resource Center, YWCA, Independent Living, Legal Action of Wisconsin and CAC.

If you live in City of Madison, Middleton, Fitchburg, Monona, Town of Madison, Shorewood, Maple Bluff or Town of Blooming Grove - this is Greater Madison.

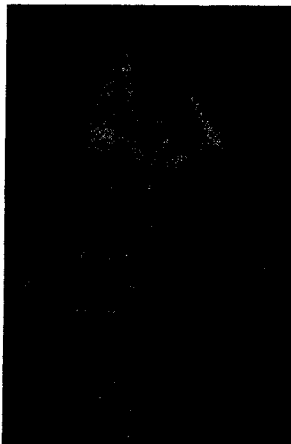
#### *In surrounding Dane County:*

Porchlight, Tenant Resource Center, Independent Living, Stoughton Area Resource Team (START), Legal Action of Wisconsin and CAC.

If you live in any other location in Dane County not listed as Greater Madison - this is Dane County HPRP.

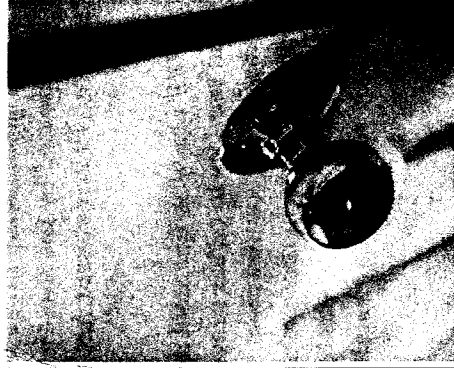
